



## Key Stage 2 (KS2) Results 2015

This is a summary of the levels achieved by pupils who left year 6 in the summer term 2015. Level 4 was the nationally expected level of attainment for children leaving year 6. Level 5 and 6 indicates children working above and significantly above the expected level.

Two levels of progress from Key stage 1 to Key Stage 2 was the national expectation.
