The Government's sports funding ensures our children receive the highest level of sports provision and enables all pupils to have access to sporting opportunities, in addition to being taught PE.

Our Successes

As a result of this funding, the embedded extra-curricular clubs and the skills development of our pupils during 2017, we have built on our sporting successes from 2016, including; The Boys' Football Team winning the Brent Cup and the Girls' Football Team getting through to the league finals, and individual pupils representing Brent in tennis in the London Youth Games. We also took part in inter-school competitions as part of the Kingsbury Schools cluster; Years 3-6 took part in tennis and table-tennis competitions, where the winners were awarded trophies at our Sports Presentation Breakfast. We monitor our successes through the competitions we take part in, as well as children's questionnaires. Pupils are enthusiastic about sports and enjoy competitions.
