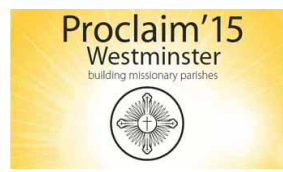

Safeguarding

As a school we have a duty of care to the children and must refer issues of concern to Social Care for further discussion and investigation. If you have a child protection or safety concern, please discuss it with your child’s teacher.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that children should be supervised using the internet and reminded about not communicating with strangers. Instagram and Facebook are not suitable for primary school children and have a minimum age to sign up of 13 years old. We report the accounts of children who are underage and log this as an e-safety concern. Please also ensure that your children do not view adult material on television or on the internet, or use computer games classified as 12, 15 or 18. If we wish to protect their childhood we need to encourage safe internet use by all children.
