



Data Protection & GDPR

On 25th May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation GDPR came into force. It replaced the Data Protection Act and endeavours to strengthen the security of data held within organisations. The School has conducted work to ensure that we comply with the regulation.

Parents, pupils and members of staff have the right to: -

- be informed about how we use personal data
- request access to the data
- request that the data is amended if it is inaccurate or incomplete
- request that the processing of data is restricted
- object to personal data being processed

Privacy Notices for pupils, parents, volunteers, staff and job applicants have been prepared and are available on the School website.

Subject access requests (SAR) can be submitted by making a formal request in writing to admin@robsouth.org.
