<p align="center">Maths</p> <p>In the Spring Term, Year 1 will focus on <i>Number</i></p> <p>Children will focus on Place Value within 50. They will be counting and writing numbers to 100 and from 100 to 0; studying ordinal numbers; looking at addition and subtraction to 20; and learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s.</p> <p align="center"><i>Measurement</i></p> <p>We will look at length and height and weight and volume.</p>	<p align="center">History</p> <p><i>Oliver Goldsmith, John Logie Baird, Amy Johnson and Ernest Trobridge.</i></p> <p>Year 1 will study the lives of each of these local heroes and why they have made such an impact on our lives. We will also make a timeline; show differences between their time and ours; and note similarities and differences.</p> <p align="center"><i>Wembley Stadium</i></p> <p>We also plan to look at the history of our local, amazing Wembley Stadium.</p>	<p align="center">English</p> <p>This term, the children will read a range of stories written by Janet and Allan Ahlberg. They will enjoy <i>The Jolly Postman</i>, <i>Funnybones</i>, <i>Peepo</i>, <i>Cops and Robbers</i>, <i>Mrs Wobble the Waitress</i>, <i>Mr Biff the Boxer</i> and <i>Mr Tick the Teacher</i>. Children will write narratives, a poem and a postcard, and will focus on writing in sentences using capital letters, full stops and the introduction of adjectives. Spelling rules will be taught and revised weekly. Phonics will be taught daily in small groups.</p>
<p align="center">Science</p> <p>This term the children will study <i>Materials</i></p> <p>They will learn about the 5 main groups of Materials - stone, plastic, metal, wood and fabric. They will learn how to identify and describe the properties of each group. Children will also learn how to ask scientific questions, predict, carry out a simple test and explain their findings.
