ST ROBERT SOUTHWELL SCHOOL is a Catholic foundation for the education of baptised Catholic children.

The admission of pupils rests with the Board of Governors, based on the published admissions criteria. This should be read in conjunction with the Statement of the Bishops.

If you wish to apply for a place in the Nursery, the following must be sent to school:

- **Application Form**
- **Proof of address**
- **Copy of child's Baptismal Certificate**
- **Copy of child's Birth Certificate**

Completed applications should be returned to the school office **by 3.00pm on Tuesday 14th January 2022**. Late applications will not be considered in the first round of offers.

ADMISSIONS TO SCHOOLS – STATEMENT APPROVED BY THE BISHOPS

The admissions policy of the Bishops is based upon the understanding that each Catholic school is founded by the Church, with the purpose of providing for members of the Catholic community. The expectation is that all those admitted to the Nursery will normally be members of Catholic families who would be expected to give unqualified support to the very specific aims and ethos of the Catholic school. The Bishops see this as the norm and as representing one of the proper ways for Governors to seek to fulfil their responsibilities in safeguarding the School's corporate Catholic life and identity, and in fulfilling its educational purposes.

The application form needs to be returned to school by **14th January 2022**. All completed applications received by this date will be treated equally, according to the admissions criteria.

Over-Subscription Criteria

Where there are more applicants for places than the number of places available, places will be offered according to the following order of priority:

1. Catholic looked after children and all previously looked after children, including those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
2. Baptised Catholic children of members of staff, where the member of staff has been a permanent employee of the school for at least two years at the time of application.
3. Baptised Catholic children who have siblings at the school at the time the child would be admitted onto the school roll.
4. Baptised Catholic children who are resident in the parish of St Sebastian & St Pancras.
5. Baptised Catholic children, resident in other parishes.
6. Other looked after children and all previously looked after children, including those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
7. Other children who will have a sibling at the school at the time the child would be admitted onto the school roll.
8. Children of Catechumens and children from other Christian Churches whose application is supported either by a certificate of baptism or by a letter from their Minister of their religion confirming membership of the faith community.
9. Any other children.

The closing date for applications is **14th January 2022**
